Cumbria Lichen and Bryophyte Group

Constitution

Adopted January 2020

- 1. The group shall be called the Cumbria Lichen and Bryophyte Group.
- 2. The aims of the group are to:
 - Encourage the study of and interest in the lichens and bryophytes of Cumbria
 - To promote their conservation.
- 3. Membership of the group shall be open to all who are interested in the lichens and bryophytes of Cumbria regardless of ability, race, age, gender, sexuality, political or religious affiliation.
- 4. A committee shall be elected at each annual general meeting, together with a named contact person.
- A special general meeting can be called by the committee or 20% of members.
- 6. All members shall be given at least two weeks' notice of an annual or special general meeting.
- 7. This constitution can be amended at a general meeting by a simple majority of those attending.
- 8. A decision to wind up the group can only be made at a general meeting. In the event of the group winding up, any resources can be distributed to organisations sharing similar aims.
